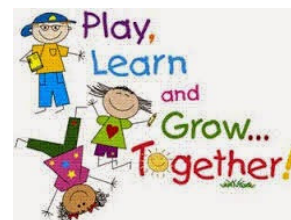

6th GRADE MUSIC AT DMS

All 6th grade students at Dickinson Middle School are required to take a music class. The choices are band or choir. Choir is not to be confused with elementary music. Students enrolled in band must have their own instrument. Instruments are available for purchase or rental at Jacobsen Music in Dickinson. It is highly recommend to use the rental program. Instruments can be reserved now or anytime throughout the summer and stored at the music store until it's time for school to start in August. Instruments will be needed on the first day of school. Due to the setup of our instrumental program students can only start band in 6th grade. Currently there are no beginning band options in 7th or 8th grade so now is your chance to start. Once a student is in grade 7 and 8 they can participate in both band and choir.

Just a few weeks ago all 5th graders had the opportunity to try out various band instruments and hopefully they shared this fun experience with their parents and have discussed their interest in joining the band program. Parents should be receiving an email in the next few days with a link to a Music Interest Form. The form information is to indicate whether a student will be participating in band or in choir. This information is important to the preparation of class schedules. Class schedules will be given out during the fall registration. The opportunity to reply to this form will need to be completed by Friday, May 4.
